I am pleased to inform you that the residents of Ballinclea Heights endorsed the installation of the proposed All Weather Court, by an overwhelming majority, at the BHRA Annual General Meeting 24/4/2006. Due to the great interest generated by the development proposals for Ballinclea Park we achieved a record breaking attendance.

The AGM mandate clearly supports and endorses the results of the extensive Questionnaire / Survey carried out by BHRA in February 2006, which obtained the views of 470 residents on the AWC and the other development proposals for the park. See attached bar chart.
